These are questions for the discipler to ask to help gather data to assist a disciple in his personal confession. Encourage the disciple to give <u>specific</u> examples regarding relevant questions. **You may need to put these questions in the past tense as well.**

1. Are you a godly role model? 2. Are you negative, critical? 3. Are you a controlling person? 4. Are you physically abusive? 5. Are you sexually abusive? 6. Are you controlled by fear? 7. Are you self-pitying? 8. Are you drug or alcohol dependent? (drunkard or drunkenness) 9.
