Introduction to...

The Discipler's Edition

The purpose of the *Discipler's Edition (DE)* is to provide for CTO disciplers our existing *Three-Part Discipleship Series* (DS3) in a format that includes easy access to some of the key resources for discipling already provided on the CTO Website. Since it is packaged for use in a three-ring notebook, it will be easy for you to customize your notebook with the discipling resources you use most frequently. With the use of a free app for your smart phone or tablet, QR codes make it possible to have easy access right from the hard copy of the DE to diagrams, teaching videos and other discipling resources available from CTO Ministries.

DE Contents:

- (1) The complete DS3 (Part 1,2,3) hole-punched with all pages paginated to match the spiral bound editions. (You will need to provide your own 1½" three-ring notebook for each part.)
- (2) A "tabbed" appendix in the back of Part One that allows you to organize your discipling tools. (You can move this entire "Appendix" into Part Two and Three as you move into those studies.)
- (3) Slip-in cover pages and spine labels for each of your own 3-ring notebooks.

Key Features:

- (1) All complete Bible verses cited are listed on inserted pages adjacent to the page where they are referenced.
 - You can now "upgrade" from the Classic or an older version of the DS3 to the latest edition
 that includes new diagrams without having to "rewrite" any verses you have previously
 written out.
 - More "blank space" is available to add your own notes and comments.
 - If you do not wish to use these simply remove these inserted pages.
- (2) The *Discipler's Guides* are included at the beginning of each of the main studies.
 - These are a one page "cliff notes" review of the key concepts for each chapter with tips/helpful hints.
- (3) QR codes* are attached to each diagram, outline, checklist and other key resources for quick reference to the PDF of that diagram or the teaching video that explains that diagram.
 - Use the QR code to access the diagram on your phone or tablet for review, discussion or electronic distribution.
 - Use QR code to access different checklists (Forgiveness Checklist, Confession Checklist, etc.) to print in advance or to email to your disciple.
 - You can also easily open the PDF in I-Books and begin building your own library on your phone or tablet of the key resources you use.

*You will need a free QR or barcode reader app from the App Store or Google Play on your phone or tablet.
