





- You have truth and lies entering your mind on a continuing basis.

Immature Believer Life dominated by lies of Satan/self

- Motivated by self-centeredness
- Manifested in not trusting
 - -God's character and wisdom
 - -God's commands and promises
- Produces decisions that are disobedient to God's Word
