# FORGIVE the individual

Release an individual from your bitterness, judgment and/or wrath

UNCONDITIONAL
Between you and God

# CONFESS your sin to God

Agree with God, acknowledge your sin and take responsibility for your actions / attitudes



# **RECONCILE** by seeking forgiveness

Seek forgiveness for your sin against him/her

CONDITIONAL
Requires both parties

Although we are commanded to *reconcile*, we are not commanded to *restore* a relationship to what it previously was. (Matt. 5:23-24) In some cases restoration of the relationship may never happen or may be inappropriate.

#### **ONGOING PROCESS**

RESTORE	FORBEAR	ADMONISH	<b>FORGIVE</b>
Over time demonstrate repentance and restore trust	Forbear with offenses when appropriate	Biblically admonish when appropriate and when prompted by the Holy Spirit	Forgive new offenses following steps 1-3
Rebuild relationship where appropriate (Not all relationships should be restored)	Some sins may need to be overlooked	Always forgive / reconcile before admonishing	You will continue to be sinned against this side of heaven

Both parties must be willing to move forward in relationship and seek to restore trust. It will be difficult to restore the relationship if there is no repentance.

If restoration does not happen, "...so far as it depends on you, be at peace with all men." Rom. 12:18 NASB
