- I realize You have the power to turn trials into triumphs. (Ps. 30:10-12)
- I release my fears and my future into Your capable hands. (Ps. 34:4; 112:7,8a)
- I abandon myself to *Your* life plan, which You will unfold step by step, as I walk in obedience. (Ps. 139:16; 32:8)
- I understand that You are the Sustainer of my soul. (Ps. 54:4)
- I seek You to revive me in my weariness and to turn me away from vain things. (Ps. 85:6; 119:37; Is. 57:15)
- I know that You and Your Word can change me; bringing freedom and healing.(Eph. 3:20,21; John 8:31,32)
- I rest in your sovereign control and wait in expectation of the demonstration of Your goodness. (Ps. 27:13,14; 31:19)
- I entrust myself to the Man who died for me, my Shepherd, and to experience Your rest, peace and joy. (Ps. 23:1-3)
